ABOUT THE BREWERY FIELD

From 1751 to 1954, the Field, complete with dray horses for deliveries, was the site of the Westgate Brewery which produced beer for inns and pubs across Sussex.

After a community ballot in 2016, the old Henty Field was renamed The Brewery Field. It's now on a long lease from West Sussex County Council, looked after by Chichester City Council and enjoyed by the community year-round.

In 2017, shire horses and a dray were the focal point of a popular community event and this year they're back!

Join us on Sunday, August 25th! Hitch a ride, enjoy the stalls and activities, many with a green theme including Chichester's own Repair Cafe, a Teddy Bear's Picnic and local ice-cream.
