Community Speedwatch

Chichester Police are actively expanding their Community Speedwatch programme and you may have seen some of our own Speedwatch team outside No. 19 Westgate using the speed radar device or 'gun' to monitor speeds at various times of day. This is no longer just a training exercise and several cars were caught speeding. Details of these were sent to the Police who, after verification, will send letters to the owners of the vehicles. We noticed that our presence in high vis jackets with speed calming equipment definitely had an effect on slowing down most motorists. Unfortunately this address is the only one on Westgate which we are allowed to operate from due to many safety issues / junctions / parked cars etc. down the length of the road.

We would like to organise regular use of the speed 'gun' but need more trained operators as we have mentioned before. It's not difficult to take the online training and here are more detailed instructions on how to join. Please give it a try!

- 1. Click the link www.communityspeedwatch.org
- 2. Click Join Existing Group
- 3. Click on Chichester City Speedwatch Group
- 4. Fill in your details
- 5. You will be sent an email where you have to confirm the link
- 6. You will then be sent a further email with a temporary password follow instructions to log in with that password.
- 7. Click on Finish Training to start the online course. You can stop and save at any time. It consists of a series of videos (it's useful to take a few notes) each followed by a multiple choice test.
