I did not report on the Infrastructure Steering Group (ISG) meeting in the last Bulletin as I was away. The meeting was held in June and was quite reassuring in showing the amount of resistance there is from the RAs and the cycling lobby to the WHF developers' plan for the offsite traffic arrangements. However, the developers hold a signed document (S106) from the CDC Planning Department containing the old Vectos plans, and their attitude in the past has been that the plans have been signed, so that is what will be delivered. A new company called Jubb have taken over from Vectos for the delivery of the plans and they seem more amenable to discussion. They have already done a full survey of Westgate. The developers' representatives were asked to go back to their boards and request that the plans should be re-considered and local comment taken into consideration. We shall have to see their response. I am not very optimistic. We shall find out at the next ISG meeting on 4 October.

There was a meeting between our local councillors and the planning department in August, at which the WGRA was represented by Brian Cope. The meeting was to discuss the first and second reserved matters applications for the first two groups of houses on the site. Comments were made that the architects' plans lacked imagination and that there were concerns about the on site parking arrangements, but little of direct interest to Westgate residents was discussed.
